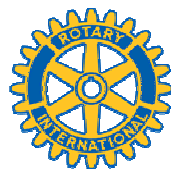

# Kids Day Out - Westport Lake

## In essence this is how it will work

- Each Rotary Club will be offered 10 place each.
- They will chose which 10 children/young adults they want to nominate.
- The Rotary Club will pay £10 per person nominated.
- Each child MUST be accompanied by a carer who takes full responsibility for the child's safety.
- A Rotarian from each club is requested to attend to chaperone and support their guests - in a non care role. They may be expected to help out on the day too (depending on demand)
- Each child will be given a T Shirt and packed lunch included in the price
- Activities will take place all day and time table will be issued so that everybody gets to sample as many activities as they wish.
- Attendees can come along for a full or half day of for a couple of hours - whatever suits them best.
- All activities have been laid on with disability in mind and most activities are suitable for all.
