

## Interact Trophy (Best Project)

This award, in the form of a shield, is presented at the RIBI Annual Conference, to an Interact Club for the best overall project in terms of impact of project, overall scope and innovation. The project must be completed during the calendar year prior to the award being made

**Eligible nominees:** Interact Clubs.

**Who can nominate:** The District or Club Youth Service Chairman.

**Deadline:** Project completed by 31<sup>st</sup> December, with the completed application being received at RIBI by 31<sup>st</sup> January

**Awarded by:** The RIBI Youth Service Group.

### Guidance for Entries

Suggested items to include in the entry;

Name of Interact Club

Name of Sponsoring Rotary Club and District

Name and contact details of Rotary Liaison Officer or person submitting the entry

Background information about the project

What has been the overall benefit of the project and whom/what has benefited?

Why was this project chosen i.e. teacher in school had experience of the project

How were funds raised and how much?

Was it match funded?

What the money was used for?

Was it a project that didn't involve fund raising, but rather time and commitment? If so what commitment was undertaken?

Have Interactors visited the project and participated?

If it was linked to a school/youth group, did it result in an Interact/RotaKids/Rotaract club?

Was it linked to Rotary key areas? ie;

- Eradication of poverty, hunger and malnutrition
- Improvement of water supplies and sanitation
- Reduction of child mortality
- Control of diseases
- Achievement of education for all

Projects do not have to be linked to these areas

Include within the entry newspaper articles, letters of thanks, photos – items that will support that this project has been for the benefit of others

The submission will be in the form of a file/folder/scrap book
