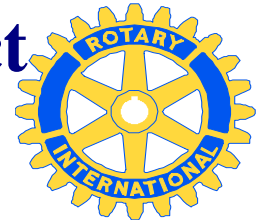

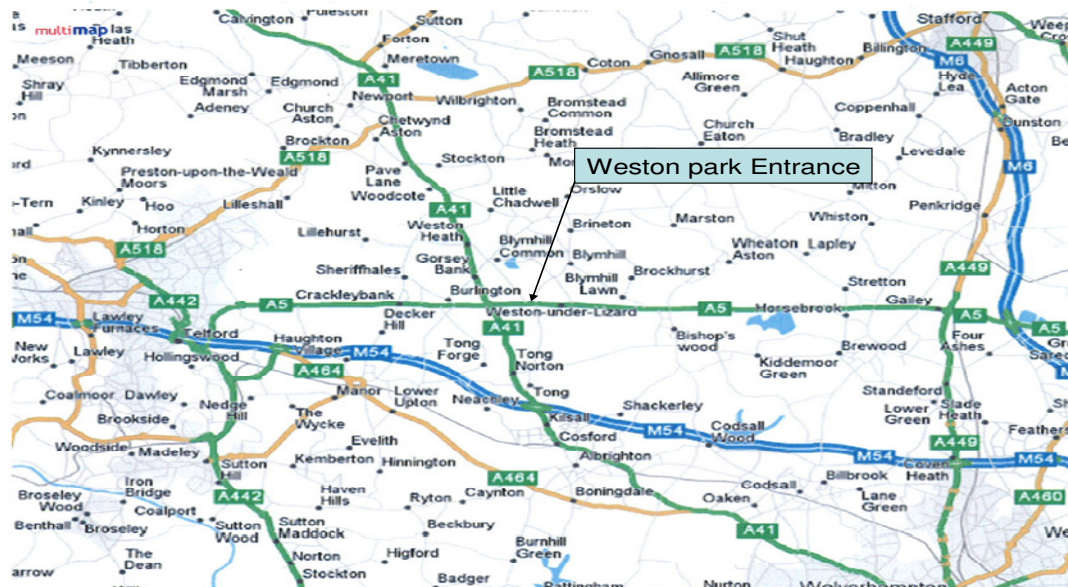

On arrival in the Park follow directions given by marshals & signage to an assembly point

What to bring with You

- Wear strong shoes and bring Wellingtons (just in case its wet)
- Gloves
- Weather proof jacket
- Food and drinks
- Mobile phone
- Rotary Tabbards or other Organisation Tabbards

Health and Safety

- A Tabbard or Luminous Jacket **MUST** be worn at all times whilst on site.
- Any request made by the Team Leader **MUST** be complied with.
- No one is to wander away from their designated area without the knowledge of their Team Leader.
- All Site Notices **MUST** be complied with.
- Everyone **MUST** be made aware that there will be heavy vehicles moving around the site.
- There will be toilets available around the site (please use them)
- Before dismantling tents, ensure that their contents have been emptied.(Shake the tent as necessary) if Solvents or needles are found, report the findings to your Team Leader.
- Before leaving site you **MUST** report to your Team Leader.

Tent Collections

- Work in groups of two/three
- Identify tents which are clean and not damaged
- **Ensure tent, poles and pegs are wrapped together**
- Use the tent bag which will be probably lying near the tent
- Place the tents in a neat pile adjacent to the road for pick up
- **As a preference identify the larger tents to pack**
- Other equipment, which can be sent abroad, are Folding chairs, clean & dry bedding, usable cooking equipment, Wellington boots and other items.(Please note that Folding Chairs will be collected by Outside Contractor)

Please Note

As a priority, the larger tents are required, as these normally will be of a better quality than the (pop-up tents) **Please ensure that all parts are of the tents are collected. Unfortunately last year a number of tents were made unusable by inadequate packing, thereby losing some of the parts.**
