## **ROTARY** Christmas Toy Box(es)

In supporting both KidsOut and ALL Refuges within Rotary GB&I, we are pleased to announce a NEW *initiative* to replace the cancelled Festive Fun Day.

**'Every Refuge, Every Child'** In partnership with KidsOut, we are seeking support and involvement from Rotary Clubs in helping their own <u>local</u> Refuge.

Asking Clubs to sponsor the purchase of a Rotary Club <u>branded</u> 'Rotary Christmas Toy Box', containing over £80 worth of new toys (specified by KidsOut). One Rotary Christmas Toy Box at a cost of £25.00 per child, each Rotary Christmas Toy Box being filled suitable for a child by Age (0-13 yrs) and gender.

#### KidsOut Supporting Rotary GB&I Refuges throughout the Covid 19 Pandemic.

Kidsout are Official Rotary GB&I Charity Partners, started by Rotarians 30 years ago!

A brief resume of the work done with and for Refuges since the start of Covid 19 and continues:

Food vouchers – 8,900 to date with over 7,500 going out in next 6 months.

Free BT Wifi to all 330 refuges.

Over 9,000 toy boxes last financial year with an additional 15,000 forecast into 2021.

- 1 communal computer per refuge (330) by end of year, plus 2 school laptops per refuge by end of March.
- 2 Phyzzpod sensory rooms last financial year and an additional 2 Sensory rooms planned by end of year.

Cinema for 3,500 mothers and 5,600 children – August and December.

Supplied 30,000+ loose toys.
